

Driver CPC Training (Driver Certificate of Professional Competence)

2014 – ARE YOU PREPARED?

If you obtained your LGV (Large Goods Vehicle) licence prior to September 2009 and wish to continue driving commercially (hire and reward) on the road after September 2014, you are required by law to undergo 35 hours of periodic training.

The 35 hours periodic training is broken down in to 5 x 7 hour modules. In addition to the 5 standard modules, we are able to offer additional courses which are accredited, and will count as 7 hours towards driver CPC.

- Module 1- **Drivers Hours and Tachographs**
- Module 2- **Safe Vehicle Operations and Loading**
- Module 3- **Safe and Fuel Efficient Driving**
- Module 4- **Health and Safety in Transport Operations**
- Module 5- **Efficient and Secure Transport Operations (Customer care)**
- **HSE accredited Emergency First Aid at Work**
- **ALLMI Lorry loader**

If you haven't had 35 hours periodic training registered with the DSA by September 2014 (LGV) you will no longer be able to legally drive commercially on the roads.
